Clothing: (2 Days & 2 Nights)

Think layers! It's COLD at campfire!

- Class A Uniform
- Class B shirt
- Long-sleeve shirt
- Underclothing, socks (plus extra)
- Sweatshirt/Warm Jacket
- Gloves (optional)
- Warm Pajamas/Long johns/Sweats
- Warm Hat for night (beanie)
- Hiking Boots or Tennis Shoes
- Scout Hat with Visor
- Rain Gear (to keep the rain away)

Food:

- Sack dinner for Friday night
- Refillable water bottle
- Snacks (stored in resealable bags)
- Food for meals (each patrol needs to make their own arrangements)

Additional Notes:

Please label all items with names.
Please keep car keys with you at all times.

Personal Care/Toiletries:

- Wash cloth
- Soap
- Toothbrush/paste/floss
- Hairbrush/Comb
- Lip balm
- Deodorant
- Medications (must inform advisor)

Camping Gear:

- Camping Chairs (optional)
- Lantern w/ clip to hang (optional)
- Whisk broom for sweeping tent
- Sleeping pad/air mattress
- Sleeping Bag (at least +30 rated)
- Sleeping bag liner (optional)
- Pillow (optional)
- Tarp (required!!)

Pack gear in easy-to-carry bags as the campsite may require a hike to get to. The troop will be providing the tents and cooking supplies.

Other Items:

- Back pack (small daypack)
- Flashlights/extra batteries (1/person)
- Watch
- Trash & Ziploc Bags
- Wet Wipes
- Personal First Aid Kit & Band Aids
- Camera
- Money for snacks
- "Ten Essentials"
- 2 Orange Cards.**

Sun Gear:

- Sunglasses
- Sunscreen
- Sunburn Remedy

DO NOT Bring:

- Pets RV's
- Alcoholic Beverages
- Personal BB Guns/Weapons
- Sheathed knives
- Electronic games
- Matches/lighter & Fire Starter
- Open-toed shoes
- Electronic games
- Tobacco, alcohol, drugs

BSA Ten Essentials

1. Map & Compass
2. Matches/lighter & Fire Starter ... **DO NOT BRING TO CAMPOREE**
3. **Tarp**/temp shelter
4. Whistle/signal mirror
5. Food & Water (refillable water bottle and trail snacks)
6. Extra Clothing/sunglasses/cap
7. Headlamp or flashlight
8. Rain gear
9. First Aid Kit/sunscreen/bug spray
10. Knife or Leatherman (only if scout has earned Totin Chit, no blades longer than 3", no fixed blade or sheath knives)

Since you cannot bring matches or firestarter (camp rules), I would suggest one of the following substitutes:

1. Toilet paper (partial role in a ziplock sandwich bag)
2. An emergency blanket (compact reflective blanket)
