- 3. Tarp/temp shelter
- 4. Whistle/signal mirror
- 5. Food & Water (refillable water bottle and trail snacks)
- 6. Extra Clothing/sunglasses/cap
- 7. Headlamp or flashlight
- 8. Rain gear
- 9. First Aid Kit/sunscreen/bug spray
- 10. Knife or Leatherman (only if scout has earned Totin Chit, no blades longer than 3", no fixed blade or sheath knives)

Since you cannot bring matches or firestarter (camp rules), I would suggest one of the following substitutes:

- 1. Toilet paper (partial role in a ziplock sandwich bag)
- 2. An emergency blanket (compact reflective blanket)
